Church Family Budget—People have asked about the total budget figure. This year it is a little less than \$467,000. This covers all the functions of the church except for 3 items. These 3 items are Future Building fund, Worthy Student Fund and the Caring Fund. The major portion (60%) of the Church Family Budget goes to Subsidies to Spring Valley Academy. One item we have added this year is \$10,000 for capital improvement of the church property. Things such as New Roofs, Parking Lot repair, New Tree line at the rear of the property cost extra money that we have not budgeted for in the past. At the end of this year we will have \$40,000 in this account. By having this account, we will be able to make repairs without having special fundraising requests when they are needed. Thank you for your generous gifts to the Church Family Budget. We are about \$27,000 short at the end of last week.

We believe in baptism by immersion as a symbol of receiving the new birth and a new life through Christ. Matthew 28:19,20; John 3:5; Romans 6:16

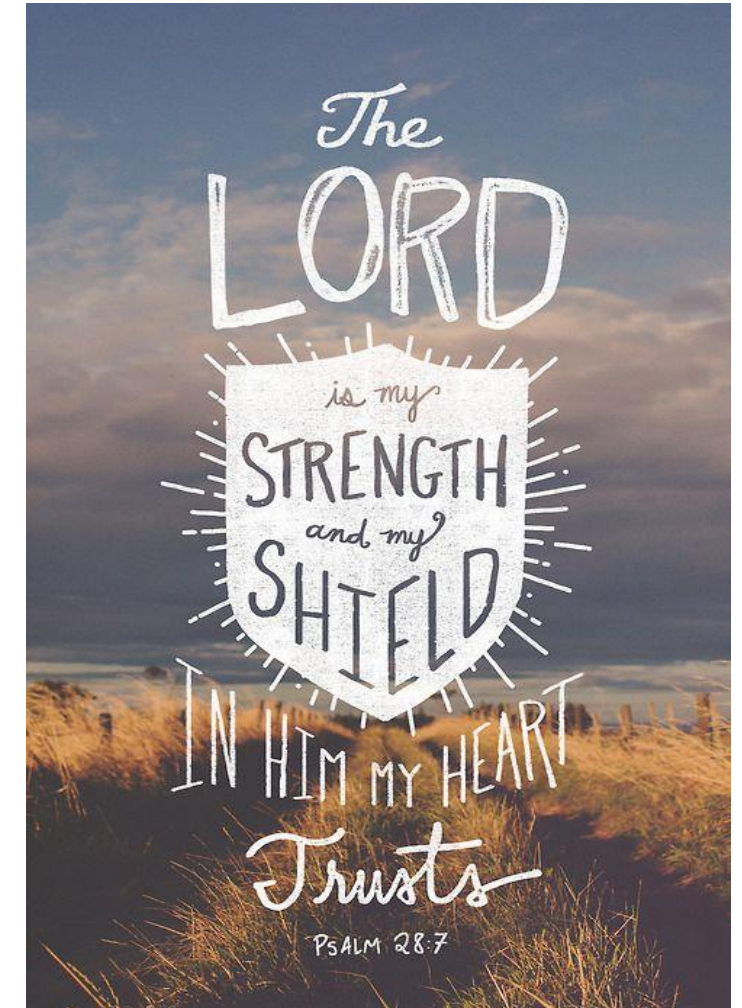
